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| 1  | <p><b>Botter, Pinot Grigio, IGT</b><br/><b>Veneto, Italy, 2010</b><br/>An intense straw colour with an ample, lasting fruity bouquet. The palate is dry, soft and well balanced.</p>   | <b>£12.25</b> |
| 2  | <p><b>Valdemoro Sauvignon Blanc</b><br/><b>Chile, Chile 2010/11</b><br/>Crisp and zesty Sauvignon Blanc showing true varietal characteristics with good acidity.</p>   | <b>£12.50</b> |
| 3  | <p><b>Willowood Chardonnay</b><br/><b>California, USA NV</b><br/>This wine is made using state of the art techniques to produce a crisp dry white wine with refreshing citrus fruit characters and a typical light buttery finish.</p>   | <b>£12.50</b> |
| 4  | <p><b>Still Bay Chenin Blanc</b><br/><b>South Africa, 2010/11</b><br/>South Africa's classic white grape varietal, this Chenin Blanc has mouth-watering tropical fruits balanced by a racy acidity.</p>  | <b>£12.50</b> |

| 9  | <p><b>Chablis, Réserve de Montaigne, J. Moreau et Fils</b><br/><b>Burgundy, France 2009/10</b><br/>The vines grow on gentle slopes along the perimeter of the Chablis Grand Cru and Premier Cru appellations. Pale gold in colour with slight green tinges and a fruity nose with butter and hazelnut aromas.</p>  | <b>£23.50</b> |
| 10 | <p><b>Botter Ca'Lunghetta, Pinot Grigio, IGT</b><br/><b>Veneto, Italy 2009/10</b><br/>This light and refreshing wine is produced in the Venezie region. An elegant bouquet with hints of ripe fruits and flowers, the palate is dry, soft and well -balanced with a full bodied structure of refreshing fruit. | 11 | <b>Botter, Senso Sangiovese</b><br><b>Italy 2009/10</b><br>This delicious red is dry, medium-bodied, with blueberry and plum flavours.   | £12.25 |
| 12 | <b>Valdemoro Cabernet Sauvignon</b><br><b>Chile, Chile 2009/10</b><br>This juicy, full bodied Cabernet Sauvignon has dark fruit flavours and a rich finish.  | £12.50 |
| 13 | <b>Willowood Merlot</b><br><b>California, USA NV</b><br>This Merlot is a delicious soft rounded red with soft hints of ripe red berries and supple tannins.  | £12.50 |
| 14 | <b>Vignoble du Sud Cabernet Sauvignon</b><br><b>Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 2009/10</b><br>A soft, smooth red wine with a good fruity nose. Excellent value from the south of France.   | £13.00 |
| 15 | <b>Alta Gloria, Malbec</b><br><b>Mendoza, Argentina 2009</b><br>Surprisingly, this Malbec is relatively easy drinking in style compared to more traditional styles of Malbec. The wine has black fruit flavours and big chunky tannins   | £13.50 |
| 16 | <b>Trig Point Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz</b><br><b>South-Eastern Australia, Australia 2008/09</b><br>Spicy, berry flavours completed by a touch of mint, dominate this wine. The warm, ripe, savoury fruit results in a soft, rounded palate showing great length.  | £14.50 |
| 17 | <b>Wild Boar Red, Vin de Pays du Var, Ch.Routas</b><br><b>Provence, France 2007/08</b><br>90% Cabernet Sauvignon; 10% Carignan. This is an unusually approachable expression of this classic varietal, deep purple in colour, exuding fruity aromas on the nose, and with the velvety character of a great Cabernet.   | £15.00 |
| 18 | <b>Côtes du Rhône Rouge, Mazets de St Victor</b><br><b>Rhone Valley, France 2009</b><br>Grenache Syrah blend with delicious dark bramble and blackcurrant flavours, juicy tannins and white pepper on the finish.  | £18.00 |
| 19 | <b>Vinea, Corvina, IGT</b><br><b>Veneto, Italy 2007/08</b><br>Corvina is the principal grape varietal used in the production of Valpolicella. The nose shows classic aromas of cherries and red berries with hints of vanilla and cinnamon from oak ageing. It is full bodied with great structure and offers an excellent alternative to more well known styles | £19.00 |
| 20 | <b>Beronia, Rioja</b><br><b>Crianza, Spain 2008</b><br>Made from 82% Tempranillo, 14% Garnacha and 4% Mazuelo. The wine is aged 12 months in barrel and 12 months in bottle prior to release. Aromas of vanilla, raspberry and cherry dominate the bouquet. The palate is fresh and fruity with a rich and powerful finish. IWC Commended                        | £21.00 |
| 21 | <b>Dom Ramos, Rioja</b><br><b>Reserva, Spain 2006</b><br>90% Tempranillo and 10% Graciano, this wine spends 18 months in barrel and a further 18 months in bottle prior to release. This has a good level of intensity on the nose showing spice, oak and vanilla giving way to a wonderful palate of cherries and vanilla.                                      | £29.00 |

**California, USA NV** **£12.50**  
 A lively, fruity rosé wine with aromas of red summer fruits and an attractive crisp sweetness on the palate.
- 23 Le Bel Olivier, Cinsault-Syrah Rose, IGP**  
**Pays d'Oc, France 2009/10** **£14.00**  
 With a vibrant pale pink colour and a raspberry, floral nose, this is a lovely refreshing rosé.

- 24 Katherine Hills Sparkling Brut**  
**South Australia, Australia NV** **£17.50**  
 This approachable and easy drinking Australian sparkling white wine has excellent fruit flavour and acidity.
- 25 Gonzalez Byass Vilarnau Brut**  
**Penèdes, Spain NV** **£19.50**  
 This delicate Cava is a brilliant, pale straw colour, with medium-size bubbles. Simple yet delicate aromas of fruits, and hints of roses and other flowers. DWWA Commended
- 26 Botter Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry DOC**  
**Italy NV** **£22.00**  
 Pale light yellow colour, with fine perlage. Delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. Well balanced and light body. Harmonic at the taste.
- 27 Champagne Mansard Brut**  
**Champagne, France NV** **£36.00**  
 Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Pinot Noir gives elegance and length, Pinot Meunier gives body weight and Chardonnay contributes aroma and finesse. There is a good amount of bottle age on the Brut Non-Vintage, making this a very attractive Champagne. **37.5cl £22.00**
- 28 Champagne Mansard Brut Rosé**  
**Champagne, France NV** **£41.00**  
 An excellent, delicate pink champagne made in the traditional method of adding still red wine to the still white wine before second fermentation in bottle. The addition of Pinot Noir (40%) gives a soft, fruity style of Champagne which is delicious.
- 29 Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut**  
**Champagne, France NV** **£43.50**  
 Although the blend is 80% Pinot Noir and Meunier. 'P-J' has a lightness and elegance which is matched by plenty of fruit on the palate. IWC Commended, DWWA Silver, IWSC Silver
- 30 Taittinger Brut Reserve**  
**Champagne, France NV** **£46.00**  
 Taittinger has long been famous for the lightness and elegance of its champagnes, attributable, in part, to the high percentage of Chardonnay in the blend. The Brut NV displays these characteristics to perfection. IWC Bronze, DWWA Gold
- 31 Dom Pérignon**  
**Champagne, France** **£150.00**  
 This stunning Champagne scores 96/100 Parker points. The 2002 Dom Perignon is at first intensely floral, with perfumed jasmine that dominates the bouquet. With time in the glass the wine gains richness as the flavours turn decidedly riper and almost tropical. Ripe apricots, passion fruit and peaches emerge from this flashy, opulent Dom Perignon.
